

APPLICATION DEADLINES 2017/2018 Erasmus +

April 30th, 2017 for an arrival in September or October 2017

September 30th, 2017 for an arrival in January or February 2018

At least 2 months before arrival for any other period of study

IMPORTANT

1/ Exchange students are meant to come to Grenoble for clinical practice.

Each clinical practice period starts at the beginning of each month.

2/ Teaching courses are optional but recommended. The schedule 2017/2018 will be provided at arrival

For information you can find enclosed the teaching schedules for 2016/2017.

No signed and stamped certificate of attendance at teaching courses will be delivered.

3/ Exchange students will start their Erasmus period provided administrative formalities are fulfilled.

4/ Language skills: Recommended level of French: B1/B2 (no certificate requested)

French language classes: optional but proposed by UGA for free during one semester only for an arrival in September/ January. For any other period- ex, October or February- it will depends on available places.

5/ Our ECTS system for clinical rotations (see below) MUST be respected.

Indeed, we can't adapt and match with all our partners. Your students will not be able to request local ECTS for such or such field of study.

Teaching courses (TC)

-Exchange medical students are integrated in our clinical years and they can attend TC in the afternoon.

- 4th/5th/ 6th year students will attend the same courses.

- TC are repeated 1st and 2nd semester as we are organized in poles (see below).

You may not follow TC coupled with the clinical placement at the same time according to our internal calendar.

BE AWARE

First Semester: From September to Christmas vacation

Second Semester: from February to the end of May

FRENCH WRITTEN EXAMS (called 'FIHU') = They will only enable the student to validate the theoretical part (for each field of study)

Information 2017/2018 is not yet available

1st semester Mid-January

2nd semester : End of May- First week of June

Clinical rotations / practice

Please be advised that you are asked to list in your Learning Agreement **each clinical rotation** as mentioned below
Mandatory to be chosen before arrival.

1 clinical rotation = 4 weeks or 8 weeks* No possible arrangement!

6 ECTS delivered for a 4 weeks placement

12 ECTS delivered for an 8 weeks placement

** 3 subjects are concerned: internal medicine, Infectious diseases, hematology*

Clinical rotations take place in the morning (for a half-day time) and are offered from September to July
(*except forensic medicine: in the afternoon*).

When filling your learning agreement

1/ You must write precise dates of your availability for clinical rotations (the start and end dates).

Ex: January / June : is not precise enough (day/ month are needed)

Ex: If you stay 1st of October/ 31st of May: you will start your "clinical placement" in October the 1st (and you will need to arrive few days before)

Ex: If you stay 15th of October/31st May : you will start your "clinical placement" in November the 1st

2/ You have to select clinical rotations among the list in ANNEXE 1 **ONLY**

Please precise in brackets, if you choose teaching courses(TC)/ clinical rotations (CR)/written exams or all of them.

Health requirements

1/ MANDATORY vaccinations asked by the university hospital policy are enclosed.

2/ Students must bring their medical documents with them at arrival; the occupational medicine of the Grenoble Alpes university hospital will check them during a medical appointment.

Students will be allowed to start his/her first clinical rotation once allowed by occupational medicine physician.

Selected students

They will receive by email an acceptance letter and our welcome guide for incoming exchange students, academic year 2017-2018 including a procedure related to accommodation in halls of residences (proposed by CROUS)

Extension of the stay **will not be accepted** after arrival.

Before arrival, such a request has to be validated and sent **by the local E+ Coordinator** (not the student)



For an arrival in September 2017 changes of clinical placement are not possible after May 31st 2017

- We will do our best to adapt clinical rotations according to students' wishes, depending on the limited places available in hospital departments.

ANNEXE 1: ORGANISATION OF THE CLINICAL ROTATION AT THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE OF GRENOBLE

A pole is composed of several related medical/ surgical specialties.

Teaching courses are organized every semester but they will not always match with your clinical rotations (i.e. cardiology teaching courses in the afternoon while your ERASMUS student is doing another clinical rotation)

Clinical rotations can be selected between different poles. However, if clinical rotations are chosen among our 5 poles, teaching courses might be difficult to follow because of overlapping schedules (i.e. cardiology teaching course of pole 1 can be scheduled at the time than endocrinology pole S3).

- Pédiatrie/ urgences pédiatriques **Few places available**
Our faculty will allocate a rotation either in polyvalent pediatrics or in a pediatric emergency unit (internal decision)

- Chirurgie infantile
- Pédo-psychiatrie
- Les urgences Adultes
=les urgences médicales et chirurgicales
Few places are available ! A good command of spoken and written French is required
- Anesthesia/ Réanimation **Few places are available. A detailed motivation letter is required**
= *post surgery*
- Réanimation médicale **Few places are available. A detailed motivation letter is required**
= *intensive care*

REGARDING "PHARMACOLOGIE", "ANATOMIE PATHOLOGIQUE", "UNITE D'HYGIENE HOSPITALIERE »:

- Pharmacologie : validation by a written exam which is usually held end of May+ optional clinical placement
- Unité d'hygiène hospitalière : available
